6-hour Adult Drivers**

**Education course before they are eligible to obtain an
Illinois driver's license.**

This law applies to any young adult, ages 18-20, who does not have a driver's license and/or has not completed the classroom portion of driver's education through a high school or commercial driving school.

Morton College is partnering with Palos Driving School to offer the six-hour classroom course necessary to immediately become eligible for a driver's license.



Upon completion of the class you can obtain your license in less than a week.
