I. Complete the general education requirements distributed as follows:**A. Communications - 9 semester hours**

ENG 101, ENG 102, and SPE 101 are required.

A minimum grade of “C” must be earned in ENG 101 and 102.

B. Behavioral Science/Social Sciences - 9 semester hours with courses selected from at least two disciplines.

Any courses from: ANT 101, **102**; ECO 101, 102; GEG 105, **115, 125**; HIS 105, 106, 180; POL 201, 202;

PSY 101, 201, 202, 210, 211, 215; SOC 100,101,102, **201**.

C. Mathematics - 4 semester hours

Choose one course from: MAT 102, 121, 124, 141, 181, 201, 202, 203, 224.

D. Science - 7 semester hours with one course selected from the life sciences and one course from the physical sciences. Lab course must be from either the Life Science OR Physical Science discipline.

Choose one course from: BIO 100, 102 L, 110 L, 140, 150, 160, 161 L, 202.

Choose one course from: CHM 105 L; GEG 101; GEL 101 L; PHS 101, 103 L; PHY 101 L.

E. Humanities - 9 semester hours

Choose one course from Fine Arts: ART 120,125, (126, 127), **217, 220**; HUM 150, 153;

MUS 100, 101, 102 (formerly 201), 103, (105,106), **108**; THR 108, 110

Choose one course from Humanities: ENG 211, 215, 216, **218**, 220, 221; HIS 103, 104;

HUM 150, 151,153,**154**; PHI **125**, (126, 180), 201, 202; SPN (202, 215, 216)

And one course from those listed above to complete 9 semester hours.

F. Health and Physical Fitness/Computer Science/College Study – 2semester hours

No more than 4 hours of PEC credit can be applied toward graduation.

Physical Fitness: Any course with PEC prefix.

Health: Any course with PEH prefix.
