## If you have experienced sexual violence:

- **GET TO A SAFE PLACE** as soon as possible.
- **CALL 911** or MC Campus Police 708.656.8000 Ext. 2200 or 2201
- **PRESERVE ALL EVIDENCE** (*do not bathe, wash your hands, or clean anything*). If you must change clothing, put all clothing you were wearing at the time of the incident in a paper (*not a plastic*) bag.
- **SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION**, immediately and preferably at an emergency room.
