- 2022 Federal Income Tax Returns, W-2's, and other records of money earned.
- Records of untaxed income (IF APPLICABLE).
- List of colleges the student would like to attend. Parents of dependent students will also need most of the same information listed above.

Documents needed for 2024-2025 FAFSA Application:

(2023-2024 FAFSA will need 2021 documents)

- Student's drivers license and Social Security number.
- Student's and/or parents 2022 Federal Tax Return (1040, 1040A, 1040EZ, W2 forms).
- Parents Social Security numbers and date of birth.
- Parents marital status (month/year).
- Records of untaxed income (Welfare, Social Security benefits, TANF, or Veterans benefits).
